Questionnaire:

- 3) Training and placement facilities are rated below average.

Useful Subjects and irrelevant subjects in current curriculum:

- 1) Not a single subject was listed as irrelevant but a part of some subjects is considered irrelevant like study of parts of aeroplane etc in Transportation subject

Industry technology which should be included in syllabus:

- 1) Software training like Primavera, Autocad etc., should be made compulsory.
- 2) Most of the subjects must be taught on field itself.


Interesting Suggestions:
