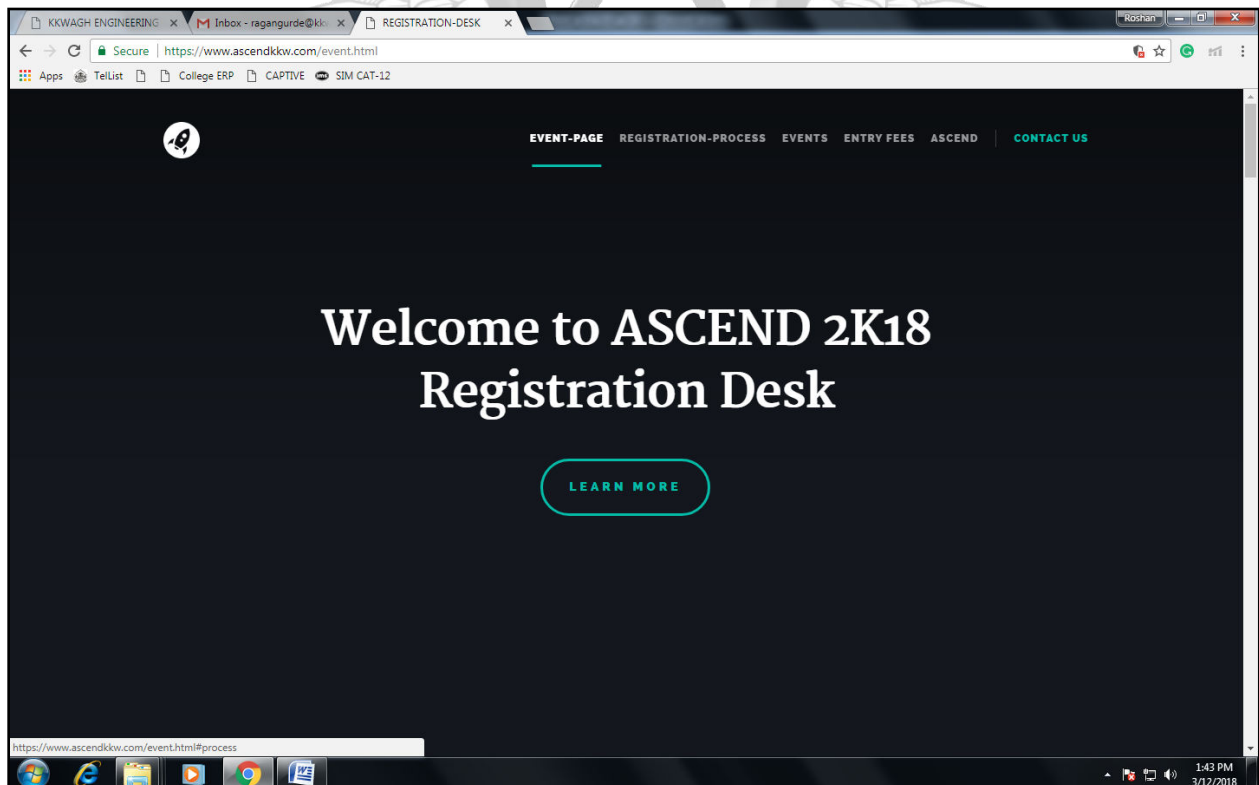

This activity mainly tests concentration, accuracy, programming skills. Problem statement is given to the participant on the spot. The developers don't need a screen or anything when they start their scripting. They just create the code in mind and run their fingers on the keyboard. This is one of the best technical event in which maximum number of students participated among the crowd. Almost 90 students from different colleges had participated. Only individual entry allowed in this event. No internet-aid will be provided. No gadgets allowed in the laboratory.

Round 3: Blind Coding (Monitor Off)

Round 4: Program Statement.

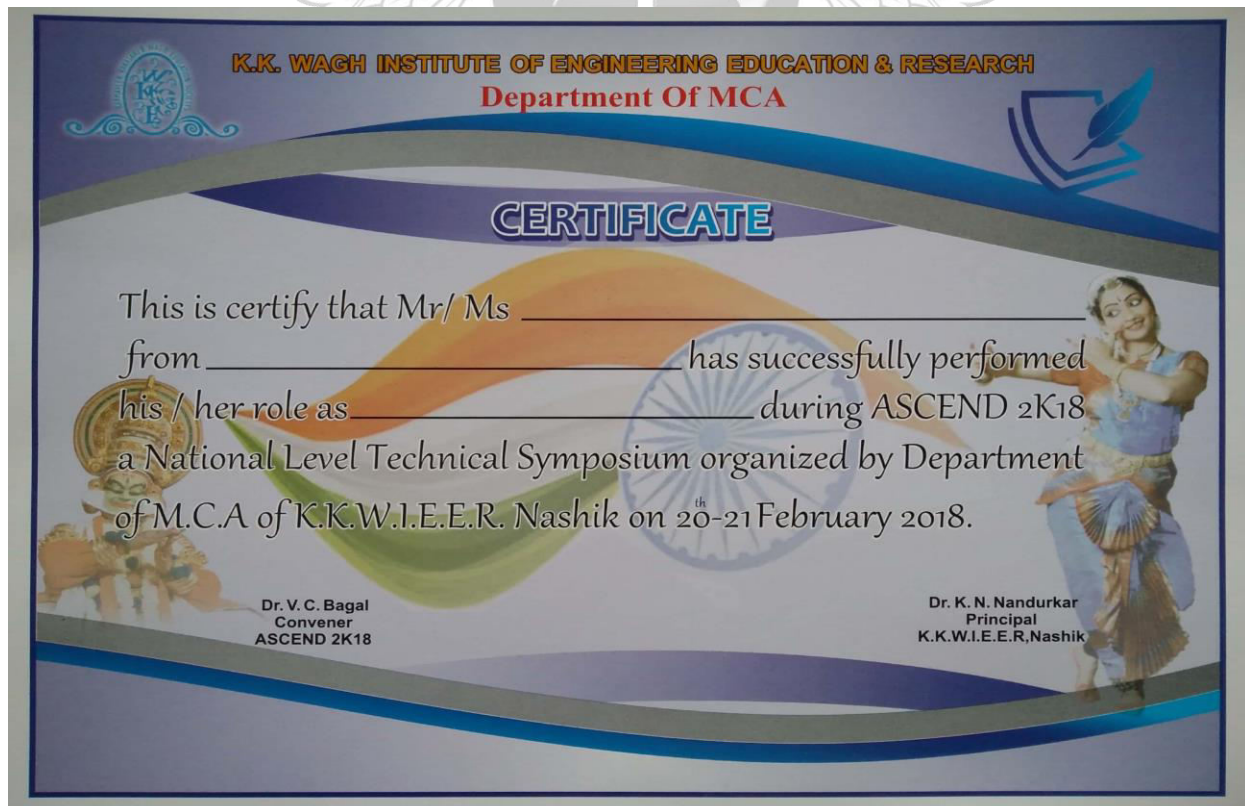
