

## *Preface of the Event*

16<sup>th</sup> September has been celebrated as **World Ozone Day**. The day is mainly intended to spread awareness of the depletion of the Ozone Layer and search for solutions to preserve it. The ozone layer, a fragile shield of gas, protects the Earth from the harmful portion of the rays of the sun, thus helping preserve life on the planet. The ozone layer acts as a shield to absorb the UV rays, and keep them from doing damage at the Earth's surface.

With this idea kept in mind the **ABACUS Club** of Department of MCA , K K Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research, Nashik has organized Social Awareness Program: Poster Competition on World Ozone Day on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

This competition was organized for First year MCA students. Total 12 posters have been displayed by participants.

The event started with inauguration of poster competition by Prof. Vilas K. Patil, Associate professor of Civil Engineering department, K. K. Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research, Nashik.

All the participants had made beautiful posters representing the importance of the ozone layer in the atmosphere and how it has been damaged over decades mainly due to human activities.

They also elucidated the precautions that could be taken to protect the ozone layer by countries, organizations and individuals.

They emphasized the need to impart knowledge and spread awareness about the far reaching consequences of the depletion of ozone in the atmosphere and how, by being an ozone friendly consumer, every individual could contribute to the replenishment of ozone to protect planet earth from the ill-effects of global warming and related phenomena, caused mainly by the depletion of the thinning of the ozone layer over the poles.

All the students of second year and third year students with faculty members of MCA department have visited the poster and encourage the first year students for their activity. First year students nicely explained the thought behind each poster and all the students and faculty members ensured to follow those thoughts for preventing the ozone layer.

After the competition, prize distribution ceremony was started with felicitation of the judge Prof. Vilask. Patil. Three participants Mr. Elliyas Pasha, Ms. OliLeela and Ms. PoojaGosavi shared their views and experience about the competition. Then first three winning group were awarded with cash prize and certificates.

Finally Prof. Vilas K. Patil addressed the students with his speech. Firstly he praised MCA dept for conducting poster competition on

'World Ozone Day' also admired the students for their ideas and participation. Then he explained importance of ozone layer in the atmosphere and how human activity has depleted this ozone layer and caused "holes" in ozone layer. He stressed on saving the ozone layer and said one should take preventive measures for saving the environment, stop using the products which are harmful for the environment, if our environment is safe, only then we are safe. Safe environment will lead to safer lives. Further he extended without the layer of ozone in the atmosphere, it would be very difficult for anything to survive on the surface and plants cannot live and grow in heavy ultraviolet radiation. The ozone layer acts as a shield to absorb the UV rays, and keep them from doing damage at the Earth's surface.
